From the Desk of *Pastor Dan* Jesus Sends Us Out!

An old *Family Circus* cartoon shows the whole family, Dad, holding PJ, Mom, Billy, Dolly and Jeffy, leaving the front doors of a church after worshiping there one Sunday morning. Five-year-old Dolly tells her Mom, **Grandma says THIS is where our religion begins...when we come out of church.** Dolly is right! Our Christian faith and witness is to be active outside the doors of our church. That's where people who need Jesus live!

Jesus calls us to mission, going out and sharing the Good News of Jesus. He did not wait for the lost to seek Him or just hang out a shingle on a carpenter's shop that read “JESUS, the Savior. Come in!” He went out of His way, across hills, valleys, rivers and lakes to find lost sinners. He said, “Go, make disciples of all people, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, teaching them all that I have commanded you...Love one another as I have loved you.”

The four Gospels tell us about many encounters Jesus had with people of all kinds. The Cross brought Him next to a criminal. He reached out and took him to Paradise. He spoke to fishermen, a woman at a well, another caught in adultery about to be stoned, to the sick, afflicted and those differently-abled and many other sinners. He showed them God's love and compassion, mercy and forgiveness. In the same way, Jesus calls us, equips us and sends us out to neighbors on our block, someone who works beside us, shoppers at HEB.

What do you say? Tell them about Jesus. We are all sinners and dead in our sins. But God loves us anyway. We all need Jesus who died to take away our sins. He gives us faith and hope, love and life, now and forever. That is what we preach and teach in Church and Sunday school, VBS, Confirmation and Bible studies and everywhere we go.

I always enjoyed seeing the simple outdoor sign posted at the exit of the last Michigan church I served: **You are now entering the mission field.** It begins as soon as you step outside this building. As you leave your parking space, remember that you are Jesus' missionary—Christ is counting on YOU to share His Good News with a conflicted, broken and hungry world.

Don't you love to tell that old, old story of Jesus and His love? And will you trust the Holy Spirit to enable you to speak and open other's hearts and minds to Christ?

What Is Via de Cristo?

Via de Cristo is a Spanish phrase meaning “Way of Christ,” and is a nationwide combined effort of laypeople and clergy to renew the church. A Via de Cristo weekend is a 3- day retreat focusing on spiritual renewal of body, mind, and spirit. It is a ministry within the Lutheran Church whose intention is to renew and strengthen Christian faith. Those attending discover a new awareness of living in the overflowing abundance of God’s grace. Through the power of the Holy Spirit and God’s grace, this course of study inspires, challenges, and equips people to be effective servants within the body of Christ. All are encouraged to strengthen their partnerships with their pastors and church families to be more active servants in the work of God’s kingdom!

Did you go to Bible Camp as a child? Via de Cristo is like a Bible Camp for adults. You will make new friends and have your faith renewed and strengthened through study, worship, singing, good food, and great fellowship. The next weekend (for men and women) will be Thursday, August 24th (starting about 6 p.m.) – Sunday, August 27th (ending about 3 p.m.) at Camp Chrysalis in Kerrville. Mission Moment

Gathered & SENT

As I sit down to write this article, my mind is full of all the last-minute arrangements that are yet to be completed for our 2023 District Gathering in New Braunfels, Texas. Yet as many of you read this, the Gathering itself will already be in the rearview mirror. I am praying for a wonderful Gathering that inspires and empowers God's people to be SENT by Jesus to be his witnesses in the world!

Our theme this year is SENT and is derived from Jesus giving the Great Commission in Acts 1:8, "You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." It is my firm belief that the church is defined by its mission. We do not simply occupy space in this world while consuming resources. We are SENT by Jesus for a mission! The challenge is for each person, and every congregation to discern what that looks like in your day-to-day life in your community and context.

I would like to invite you to take inventory of all the activities that occupy your day-to-day life, both personally as well as for your church. Typically, our lives are filled with those activities that could be broadly categorized in one of three groups: activities required to sustain life, the things that we enjoy, and then everything else! While it may be worth analyzing the stewardship of all three categories, it is this third that needs our greatest attention.

Here we may identify things that we do because of others' expectations, or traditions that simply haven't been broken or updated, and even things that we have no idea why we do them! It is tempting to replace these activities with more things that we enjoy. But I would suggest that we focus instead on pursuing mission, our God-given purpose. This third category ought to be filled with God-directed and empowered activities of purpose connected to what Jesus SENT us to do and be!

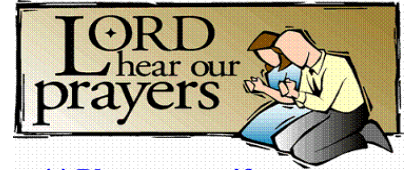
For example, churches often adopt patterns of ministry that were designed with a mission to reach their communities with the Gospel of Jesus Christ generations ago. Many churches still fill their time and expend their energy trying to maintain these same activities that were once integral to the church's mission but stopped being effective decades ago. Sometimes we need to pause and rethink what we are doing and both why and how we are doing it. Is this how Jesus is sending us to be his witnesses to our community today?

I am excited for our Gathering because we gather for a purpose. Just like Jesus' first followers in Acts 1:8, we gather to be encouraged, inspired, empowered... and SENT by Jesus to live with a mission and on purpose in our communities.

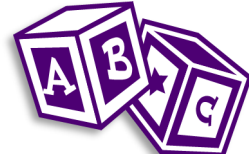

Time to Buy School Supplies for LWR School Kits

The stores have their shelves full of school supplies and the sales are on. So please remember to support the Women of Faith in providing school kits for Lutheran World Relief. In November 2022, Charity Circle sent 155 school kits to Lutheran World Relief. We could not have done it without the contributions of money or school supplies by the members of Faith.

This year, we are purchasing many of our supplies in bulk from Amazon. However, the items we need most are 70 sheet spiral notebooks (wide or college ruled) – no individual sheets of notebook paper. In order to pack 150 school kits, we need 600 of these spirals. These are not reasonably priced on Amazon.

Right now, Wal-Mart and HEB have these 70 sheet spiral notebooks for 35 cents each. (Note: At this time, Wal-Mart does not have a limit on the notebooks, but HEB does—I believe the limit is 20.) So, if you would like to support this project by purchasing school supplies, please purchase these spiral notebooks. You can place any school supplies in the appropriate bin/basket in the Narthex by the doors. If you prefer to donate money to support our online purchases, please give it to Doris Engelhardt or turn it in to the church office with school supplies noted in the memo. Thanks for your help and support in this worthwhile project.
