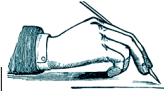

**Pastor Dan's JULY Point: R-E-S-P-E-C-T**

July begins with the celebration of our nation's 249th anniversary on the 4th of July, Independence Day! We praise and thank God for the freedom we enjoy as citizens of this great nation and, more importantly, the freedom we share in Jesus Christ. But freedom comes with responsibility. Respect toward God, our authorities and others is a big part of that responsibility, especially today!

Consider a story shared by a Lutheran pastor from Washington not long ago: On this July Fourth, allow me to introduce you to Andy Pawelczyk, who played the cymbals at Eisenhower Junior High School in Darien, Illinois. At the band's end-of-the-school-year concert, the band began playing of "The Star-Spangled Banner." This arrangement had Andy clanging his cymbals together at the end of every other line. It was impressive and loud! Then the unthinkable happened. When the band got to "bombs bursting in air," the strap on one of Andy's cymbals broke. He held the strap, but the cymbal clattered to the floor. The broken strap left him with only one cymbal and, as we all know, it's hard to get a good crash out of one cymbal.

There are some things a middle school cymbal player can do when a broken strap puts him out of commission: run off the stage; laugh or cry; throw the other cymbal at the laughing drummer. Andy did none of that. A video showed what happened. His eyes got big; he looked around; then looked to his band director for guidance. Suddenly, Andy set the other cymbal on the ground, did a quarter turn and saluted the flag until the end of the anthem. Later, he explained, "My family is very patriotic. My grandfather was in the Korean War. He taught me to salute the flag."

Another word Andy probably meant is "respect." In a world where equality has replaced authority and the good of the one outweighs the good of the many, respect is a commodity in pretty short supply. Godly respect is part of Luther's explanation to the 4th commandment: We should fear and love God that we do not dishonor or anger our parents and others in authority, but honor, serve, and obey them, and give them love and respect.

According to St. Paul, respect is one of the more public things which Christians do. Yes, there are some things- like Baptism, Communion, prayer and worship that we practice among ourselves. But paying taxes, honoring and respecting our God-given authorities is something we must do, so everyone can know that, just because Jesus is first in our lives, we aren't going to shirk our responsibility to be good citizens and respect God, our authorities and others.

Our freedom in Christ calls us to do just that! May we model such respect for our children, grandchildren and neighbors! And doing so, we love, honor and respect Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior!

## Faith Over Fear

I am so excited for our Texas District Gathering July 25-26 in Victoria! This year's theme is "All in the Same Boat" based on the story of Jesus calming the sea in Mark 4:35-41. In this story, Jesus' disciples were crossing the Sea of Galilee when a great windstorm arose and began swamping the boat. Fear struck the disciples, but Jesus was sleeping through it all. The disciples woke Jesus up: "*Teacher! Don't you care that we are going to die?*" Jesus then got up, rebuked the wind and calmed the sea.

In life and ministry, we all face challenging "storms" both as disciples of Jesus and as communities of faith. In this *Mission Moment* series, we have been leaning into the hope we have in Jesus in times of trouble. First, we remembered that we are not alone: Jesus was in the boat with the disciples the entire time the storm raged and he is with us in our storms as well. Last month I pondered whether we had grown complacent and left Jesus alone to fall asleep. Hopefully it does not take a 9-1-1 emergency for us to call on Jesus and wake him up! Instead, we should seek a relationship with Jesus through the regular reading of scripture, prayer, worship, and service.

In this final article, we recall Jesus' actions and words once the disciples woke him in Mark 4:39-40: "*He got up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, 'Silence! Be still!' The wind ceased, and there was a great calm. Then he said to them, 'Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?'*" Here Jesus connects faith and fear: When you have faith in Jesus, you have nothing to fear. Our Lord says to his followers: Trust me; Count on me; I am with you; I am ultimately in control; I will shelter and protect you; Have faith over fear.

Many people confuse this to mean that God won't ever let bad things happen to good people, but that simply isn't true. Bad things do happen all the time as the result of living in a sinful and broken world. What this really means is that in the midst of the bad things... in the suffering and hardship... when the world seems to be spinning out of control: God is with us, to help us, to strengthen us, to give us hope and see us through the storm.

Jesus calls on his followers to have faith and be at peace; to trust and not be afraid. In John 6:33, Jesus tells his disciples: "*I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. You will have suffering in this world. Be courageous! I have conquered the world.*" When God is in control, he is working for our good and his glory, even through the hard things of life. As Paul writes in Romans 8:28: "*We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God, who are called according to his purpose.*"

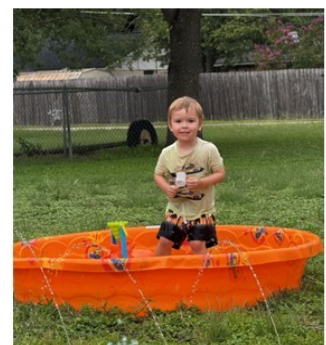
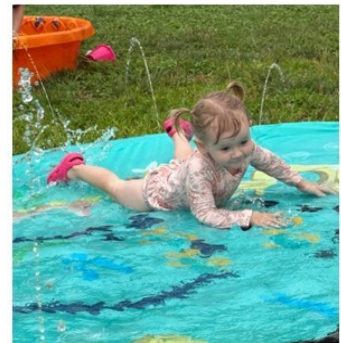
